- Cities which have passed 100% smoke-free policies have found no effect on restaurant sales.
- Secondhand smoke is the third leading cause of preventable deaths in this country, killing 53,000 non-smokers in the U.S. each year. For every eight smokers the tobacco industry kills, they take one non-smoker with them.
- Non-smoking restaurant workers inhale the equivalent of 1 1/2 to 2 packs of cigarettes a day where smoking is allowed.
- The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has classified secondhand smoke as a class A carcinogen—a substance known to cause cancer in humans.
